OUR SPEAKER IS CRAIG MISSAKIAN INSIGHT INTO BENGHAZI

The 2012 terrorist attacks in Benghazi that left four Americans dead was a tragedy. Craig will give you an insider's view of the personalities and people involved in the investigation of that attack and his thoughts about the truth of what happened and, maybe more importantly, how Hillary Clinton and the rest of the Obama administration got away without being held accountable for their actions.

Craig Missakian is a well-known trial lawyer and former state and federal prosecutor. During his 15 years in law enforcement, he earned national recognition and international attention for prosecutions that included terrorism and environmental issues, software piracy, organized crime and public corruption. He taught at the U.S.C. Gould School of Law and has been a featured speaker to groups here and abroad. He graduated Phi Beta Kappa from USC with a degree in political science and from Georgetown Law School where he was selected to be an editor of the American Criminal Law Review. He has authored a number of legal articles, including an article about the Racketeer Influenced and Corrupt Organizations Act. Mr Missakian left the U.S. Attorney's office in 2010 to enter private practice. In 2014 he was asked to serve as one of the lead lawyers in the House Select Committee on Benghazi, where he helped direct the investigation into the 2012 terrorist attack in Benghazi, Libya that took the lives of four Americans. After working on in Washington, D. C. on the Benghazi Investigation for 2 1/2 years he returned to his native Southern California where he now practices law.

Los Angeles District Attorney George Gascon has officially been served with Notice of Intention to Circulate A Recall Petition

DA Gascon was officially served today, March 8, 2021. The formal service triggers the final steps leading up to the approval and public circulation of official recall petitions. Recall organizers had to wait 90 days after Gascon was sworn in on December 7, 2020 to start the recall effort. Once approved, proponents will have 160 days to collect the 580,000 signatures from registered voters in Los Angeles County.

"George Gascon's failure to protect our most vulnerable communities is a complete dereliction of his foremost duty as a District Attorney. He must be removed from office immediately before he can do any more damage," said Tania Owen, Co-Chair of Recall Gascon Campaign. "What George Gascon is doing is not criminal justice reform, it is the outright destruction of our criminal justice system and the very laws meant to protect us."

The grounds for the recall as stated on the official notice include the following:

1. Since being elected Los Angeles County District Attorney George Gascon has abandoned crime victims and their families. Gascon has disregarded the rule of law and weakened lawful sentencing requirements for the most violent criminals, including murderers, armed robbers and rapists.
2. George Gascon's new policies treat career and repeat violent offenders as if they never committed a crime, ignoring public safety laws approved by the people. Gascon has even reduced sentences on hate crimes, gun crimes and gang crimes.
3. On behalf of crime victims and their families and in the interest of public safety, this notice of intention to recall George Gascon as Los Angeles District Attorney is submitted.

The grass roots efforts to recall Gascon is supported by victims rights advocates, former law enforcement officials, current and former prosecutors, former L.A. D.A. Steve Cooley, former L.A. City Councilman Dennis Zine, former L.A. County Supervisor Michael Antonovich, former National Director of Victims of Crime, John W. Gillis, retired Deputy Chief of LAPD Bob Green and many others. LEGISLATIVE UPDATE TAKING BACK CALIFORNIA, JOIN THE FIGHT

The speaker at the Lincoln Club on March 5, 2021 was criminal law expert Siannah Boutte, Esq. She is working with former Los Angeles County DA Steve Cooley to warn the public about the dangers of the new DA George Gascon, a dangerous radical leftist Democrat whose campaign was financed by the nefarious billionaire, George Soros. He donated \$6 million.

A recall is being planned, but cannot be started until Gascon has completed 90 days in office. Signatures will start being gathered on April first for his recall. 600,000 signatures are needed. In Memoriam REMEMBERING RUSH

Rush Hudson Limbaugh II was born January 12, 1951 in Cape Girardeau, Missouri. He died on February 17, 2021 and is survived by his beloved wife, Kathryn. He lives on in our memories, not only for the person he was, but for all he accomplished in his life.

Sean Hannity said in remembrance: "Rush was a legendary broadcaster and a great patriot. God, faith, family, country: this is what Rush Limbaugh embodied and tens of millions of Americans listened. He was an innovator, he was a pioneer, he was a trailblazer, he was a great patriot. He fought every single day to make this country a more perfect union and a better place."

Rush was born into a prominent military and legal elite family. At an early age, Rush's individualism was on display, school held no fascination for him. He claimed that he decided his future career at the age of eight, which did not coincide with his father's agenda. At the age of nine he was given a toy radio and the rest, as it is said, is history.

After high school, he enlisted in the military, but his application was rejected for health reasons. At the urging of his family, he enrolled in Southeast Missouri University, but he dropped out after two semesters.

He held many jobs in the broadcasting field. The Rush Limbaugh Show debuted on August 1, 1988 and within five years the show grew from 50 to 600 stations before President Clinton was elected. He is considered the father of talk radio. Rush did his homework, before his radio shows, but spoke for three hours with no script.

Rush is the author of many books, including the Rush Revere series aimed at the young and depicting the true great events in our history.

Rush was honored by President Donald Trump in February 2020 at the State of the Union Address, with the Presidential Medal of Freedom.

Rush Limbaugh was honored at CPAC with induction into the Conservative Hall of Fame.

Pelosi wants to stack the deck against Republicans by federalizing elections. We can put an end to these attempts to fundamentally alter the way our elections are run, but to do so we need to elect a Republican majority.

What a month it has been for the socialist agenda in Congress. First, Nancy Pelosi passed the \$1.9 trillion COCID relief package in the House - **in the middle of the night** - without a single Republican vote.

Then Pelosi and House Democrats pushed through another outrageous piece of legislation - H.R. 1, a massive election reform bill, which if passed by the Senate would enable **Democrats** to cement a **permanent Congressional majority**.

How? By requiring states to adopt national voting standards set forth by Democrats in Congress including:

1. Allowing government agencies to **ignore immigration status** when referring applicants to elections boards under "automatic" voter registration and
2. Doing away with state voter-ID laws. No ID to verify voter eligibility? No problem!

While the entire bill is rubbish, there are several provisions that worry me more than others. Should Senate Democrats pass H.R. 1:

1. Members of Congress would be entitled to taxpayer money to fund their campaigns-up to \$5 MILLION dollars
2. Congress will be committed to delivering "full congressional voting rights to the District of Columbia (Washington D.C.)" by bypassing a vote on D.C. statehood which cannot pass in a bill of its own.

It is our duty to raise awareness about Pelosi's blatant attempt to amass a permanent Democrat majority in Congress. Democrats are not going to adopt rules from states who have their act together, like Ohio and Florida, they are going to take their cue from Pennsylvania, New York, California and Illinois. Consider that while Florida was able to count more than 11 million votes in the run up to Election Day, it took Pennsylvania more than two weeks to count their votes.

On a final note: with the adoption of H.R.1, it will become exponentially harder for states to update voter rolls without federal oversight. That will lead to more and more voter fraud.

We must act before it is too late.


